Dear Parents,

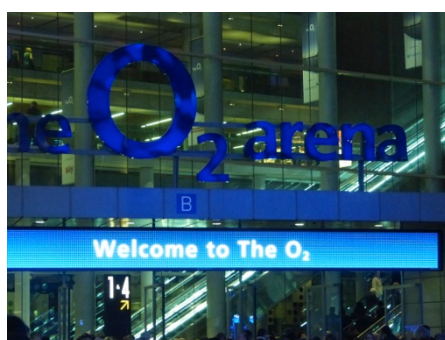
We are all very excited to be starting the new year in our new school. We are growing in size and we now have 350 pupils.
