Literacy

Read stories about farms and the care of animals that promote our school values READY and RESPECTFUL.

Be helped to notice and investigate print in the environment

Use non-fiction texts to discover more about the chicks hatching in the nursery.

Understanding The World

Learn about baby and adult animals and observe how living chicks change as they grow.

Learn about my own growth.

Be interested in different occupations and ways of life.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Talk about my home environment and family e.g. who does what around the house?

Understand why we must help our friends

Wait to take turns.

Know how to look after our things and care for living things

Respond to what others are doing and am learning how to initiate play with my friends.

Physical Development

Kick and catch balls, balance on one foot and move actively and safely in different ways across our play equipment

Make marks of all sizes and use one-handed tools and equipment including scissors and other tools safely

Continue to keep myself and others safe by following high standards of hygiene

Maths

Match numerals to quantities to 10 and beyond

Make marks to represent numerals.

Use small world to count and label animals.

Begin to have experience of early addition and subtraction through songs, games and practical activities
