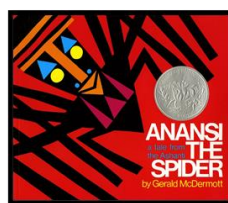
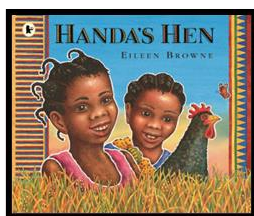
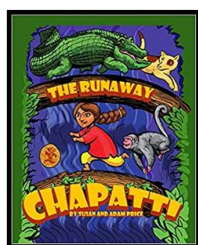

Literacy

Talk about past and present events in my life

Know about similarities and differences in relation to places, people and the world around me

Be aware that not everyone enjoys the same things as I do and be sensitive to this

Show confidence to speak to others about my own needs and interests
