Working Together – What We Ask of Parents and Carers

1. Show Respect and Care

- We ask everyone to treat each other with kindness and respect.
- Please speak to staff, children and other parents calmly and courteously – we are all role models for our children.

2. Support Learning and High Standards

- Encourage your child to be ready to learn and to try their best each day.
- Help by making sure they attend regularly, arrive on time, and complete home learning.

3. Communicate Positively

- We welcome your feedback and concerns – please talk to us.
- Use respectful and constructive language, and always come to staff directly rather than posting concerns on social media.

4. Model Positive Behaviour

- Children learn by example. Please model calm, respectful and safe behaviour at the school gate, at events and when speaking with staff.

5. Help Keep Our School Safe

- Please follow school procedures to help keep everyone safe, including mobile phone use, drop-off and pick-up, and safeguarding protocols.
- If something worries you, speak to a member of staff rather than trying to sort it out yourself.

6. Celebrate Our School Community

- We are proud of Woolmore – and hope you are too!
- Come to events, share in your child's learning and help us build a strong, inclusive school community.
