Top Online Safety Tips for Families

1. Protect Personal Information

- **Tip:** Remind children not to share personal details like their full name, address, or school name online.
- **What to Do:** If they see something uncomfortable, they should talk to a trusted adult right away.

2. Promote Kindness and Respect Online

- **Be Kind:** Encourage respectful behaviour in online chats or games.
- **What to Do:** If they see or experience unkind behaviour, teach them to share it with you or a trusted adult.

3. Create Healthy Screen Habits

- **Agree on daily screen-free times:** Regular breaks help keep screen time balanced.
- **Other Activities:** Try outdoor play, reading, or creative hobbies to balance screen time.

4. Encourage Safe Searching

- Use **child-friendly** search engines like Kiddle, Swiggle, and KidRex to help filter out **inappropriate** content.

5. YouTube Safety

- **YouTube Kids:** Set up YouTube Kids for age-appropriate content and parental controls.
- On regular YouTube, **turn on Restricted Mode** to filter content.
- **Watch together** so you can discuss what they're watching.

- **Check privacy settings** on games and limit chats to **friends only**.
- **Play Together:** Join your child in their games to monitor and ensure safe interactions.

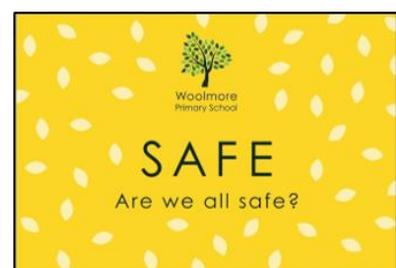
6. Model Positive Online Behaviour
