Instead of saying no nursery provision we have put together a nursery outreach programme for our families.

This programme has been designed to impact on school readiness for the children and to support parents as first teachers.

Our three day programme revolves around the Idea Store, Chrisp Street children's centre and a community hall in the Robin Hood Estate.

There is a combination of play and stay sessions, reading and literacy focused sessions and parent education classes including school readiness, ECAT and learning through play.
