

## The Colour Wheel

The **colour wheel** is a diagram that shows how colours are organised. The secondary colours sit between the primary colours from which they are made.



## Collage

Collage is art in which pieces of paper, photographs, fabric and other materials are arranged and stuck down onto a supporting surface.

fauvism	A style of painting with vivid (bright) use of colour that was popular in France from 1905.			
abstract art	Art that does not try to show how something really looks but instead uses shapes, colours, forms and marks to achieve its effect.			
tinting	A tint is where an artist adds a colour to white to create a lighter version of the colour.			
shading	The darkening or colouring of an illustration.			
mixed media	Is an artwork in which more than one medium or material has been used.			
hues	A version of a colour.			
colour wheel	A tool used in art and design to show colours and their relationship to each other.
