School Uniform

Our feedback from parents tells us that you really want all children to wear smart school uniform, so here is a reminder about what we will be expecting from September:

- School polo shirt (red or green until December)
- Navy school sweatshirt or cardigan
- Navy or black trousers/jogging bottoms/skirts/pinafore/kameez
- Black shoes/trainers without logos (no astroturfs)
- If scarves are worn they should be plain black or white, neat and not cover the uniform

PE KIT

All children must have a PE kit that they change into for PE lessons.

- Plain white t-shirt
- Navy shorts/legging/track-suit bottoms
- Trainers
- Children in Y5 and Y6 need a swimming kit.

Swimming hats and PE bags are available from the school office.

Change to school uniform

Although there have been some requests to completely change the uniform when we move to the new school we feel this is not practical. However, to show that we are going to a brand new school, in January 2015 we will be changing one aspect: the polo shirts. Instead of red and green the options will be white or orange. This was met with general approval at the recent meeting with parents. We recognise that this is an additional expense for parents and we will be letting you know about special offers next term.
